Commentary

This course provided students with an introduction to the study and practice of medicine in the UK. Students had opportunities to engage in depth with topics they found interesting; for example through their choice of essay topic for their written assessment. There was a balance of theoretical and practical learning; with students encouraged to critically examine a variety of media. Learning continued outside the classroom, on two organised tours of London museums with interactive medical exhibitions. Emphasis was placed on the importance of teamwork and communication skills for effective medical practice. Christiana was well prepared in classes and demonstrated the ability to apply her knowledge by engaging in discussing case studies. I was further impressed by her submitted essay on "deep brain stimulation", which was well researched and included an extensive list of references. During group presentations she was always clear in sharing information and could impressively paraphrase medical content so that it was understandable to her peers. She also engaged in quizzes and scored well. My only comment is that she seemed a bit shy throughout the course. However, I very much appreciated her engagement whenever she was specifically addressed with a scenario or question. I see no reason for her being hesitant as she is clever and has lots of potential when she raises her voice. Overall, I am pleased with Christiana's performance and I am convinced she will do well academically in the future.
